General rules about subject choices in S6

Total: min 31 ≤ Periods ≤ max 35

The limit of 35 periods may be exceeded, up to a maximum of 36 periods. If this occurs, you must request a derogation from school management.

• <u>Core subjects</u> = Basic + options + advanced: <u>Min 29</u> periods (= all subjects without complementary subjects)

4 periods option: min 2 ≤ Options ≤ max 4

Tip: 3 options give more flexibility for the BAC examination

Key to understand the choice grid:

- Each line on the grid means one period in the timetable. Therefore, if two courses are on the same line, they are mutually exclusive.
- All abbreviations are explained at the end of the document and grid.
- A course is a **complete unit**: if you choose one, you must take all its periods. For example, if it is a four-period course, you cannot take only two or three periods of it.

How to fill the grid?

You can circle or highlight electronically or on paper (and then scan the document). Either way is fine as long as you send me the grid afterwards.

- L1 (line 1 to 4): it is your language section (except if you are an Estonian or Latvian SWALS student)
- L2 (line 5 to 7): you can choose between German (DE), English (EN), French (FR) and Spanish (ES). if you are an Estonian or Latvian SWALS student, this is the language of the section you are joining in)
- REL/MOR (line 10): you have to specify if you choose morale (= ethics) or a religion (Catholic, Islamic, Judaic, Orthodox, Protestant)
- History (HI) and Geography (GE) (line 14 to 21): you must choose one course of each (HI2 or HI4 and GE2 or GE4)
- Philosophy (PH): you must choose one course: PH2 (line 8 and 9) or PH4
- Sciences: you must choose at least one science: Biology4 (BI4), Chemistry (CHI), Physics (PHY) or Science, Technology and Society (STS)
- And then you can choose other options and/or an advanced course and/or a complementary course...
 - following the general rules explained above and
 - o leaving two periods available for the EP (Physical Education) course
